Victoria De La Rosa joined the Ministry of Economy and Finance in 2016 to support the Office of the Minister from the Office of Advisors, carrying out special projects to analyze proposals for new public policy programs, participating in the structuring of new laws with economic and social impact in the country, such as the new law on Public-Private Partnerships. In 2018, she moved to the Office of the Vice Minister of Economy as an Advisor, supporting various economic analyses, and as a representative of the MEF at the Cooperation Table, during the first rounds of negotiation of the Free Trade Agreement with the People's Republic of China. In September 2019, she moved to the Public Financing Directorate, as Head of the Negotiation and Investor Relations Department, directing the sections of International Cooperation, Loan Negotiation and Local Capital Market, participating in the structuring of various financing schemes for the State, contracting loans, and structuring local bond issues. In December 2022, she was appointed as Deputy Director of Public Financing.

Previously, she worked at the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO), in Rome, Italy, in support of the Project Evaluation department, where she developed a meta-analysis of FAO projects in Guatemala. Prior to this, she was in charge of the Process Improvement Program of the Legal Department of Caterpillar Inc. in Panama.
